The Minimum crew requirements are:

NCR Ch.11 App.1 Art.5.1a Rescue Unit: Race and Rallycross Events. Three Licensed Rescue crew members holding a minimum of Rescue Operator Licence grade, at least one of whom should hold a Rescue Crew Chief Licence grade. Immediate medical support must be available from a Doctor or ASN Registered Paramedic who may attend independently.

NCR Ch.11 App.1 Art.5.1b Technical Rescue Unit: Race and Rallycross Events. Three Licensed Rescue crew members holding a minimum of Rescue Operator Licence grade, at least one of whom should hold a Rescue Crew Chief Licence grade.

NCR Ch.11 App.1 Art.5.1c Rescue Unit: Rally and Speed Events only. Two Licensed Rescue crew members holding a minimum of Rescue Operator Licence grade, at least one of whom should hold a Rescue Crew Chief Licence grade. Immediate medical support must be available from a Doctor or ASN Registered Paramedic who may attend independently.

NCR Ch.11 App.1 Art.5.1d Technical Rescue Unit: Rally and Speed Events only. Two Licensed Rescue crew members holding a minimum of Rescue Operator Licence grade, at least one of whom should hold a Rescue Crew Chief Licence grade.

NCR Ch.11 App.1 Art.5.2 At no time at any Event may the crew of a Licensed Rescue Unit include more than two Rescue trainees or Rescue Observers or combination thereof.

NCR Ch.11 App.1 Art.5.4 If no Rescue crew member holding a Rescue Crew Chief Licence grade can attend the event due to unforeseen circumstances, then advice must be sought from the ASN through the ASN Steward in advance of the stage or event starting.

A separate form MUST be completed for each Rescue unit in attendance.

Rallies & Other Events: As soon as practicable
